SCHOOL FACILITIES

Facilities Master Plan

The Board requires a facilities master plan be developed for the efficient and effective management of current facilities and future needs. The master plan will cover a five-(5)-year period, will be reviewed annually by the Board, and will include at least the following:

- a cost analysis of the financial ability of the District to implement its facilities program;
- existing and projected student enrollment figures;
- an inventory of undeveloped property and developed facilities, including an analysis of the number of students in each facility and whether a facility is overcrowded or underutilized;
- an analysis of the appropriateness of facilities to meet student needs including accessibility of both sexes and those with handicapping conditions;
- recommendations for sale or other disposition of District property deemed as not being needed in the future; and
- recommendations for acquisition, construction, or modification of new sites for facilities, including how they may better meet student needs and the educational program of the District.
