THE FIRST DAY OF SCHOOL IS A FULL DAY OF SCHOOL; 7:30a-2:15p!

On the first day of school, parents may accompany their children to the playground beginning at 7:00a until students line up and enter the school building at 7:25a. Per Kyrene School District guidelines, parents may not enter the building with their child. Staff will be available to help students who need assistance.

If your child **will not** be returning to Mariposa next year, please notify the office as soon as possible at 480-541-3800! If your child will be continuing with us, they will automatically be enrolled. Additionally, it is your responsibility to keep your ParentVue account up to date with your current contact information, address and emergency contacts.

The first day of school for the 2024-2025 school year is **July 24th**. State law now prohibits schools from keeping students enrolled who do not attend school during the first days of school. As you are planning your summer vacations, please be aware that if your child does not attend school during the first few days, it could impact their enrollment. The best way to ensure your child is continuously enrolled at our school is to make sure they are back at school beginning on July 24th.

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
All families are automatically enrolled to receive **email** and **phone calls**. No sign up required!

Dismissal Procedures

Dismissal Procedures

Campus opens at 7:00am and dismisses at 2:15pm (Wednesdays at 12:15pm)

For the safety of your child, all parents and staff, we have new dismissal procedures. Please follow the guidelines below:

Parking and Crosswalk Guidelines:

- Do not park in the City of Tempe "No Parking" zones, designated by signs and cones, between the hours 7:00 am- 3:00 pm, school days only.
- Use designated crosswalks at all times.
 - After school ONLY, the east bike rack CROSSWALK will be closed.



Car Line Pick-up Procedures

- Display placards with your child's full name/grade level on your dashboard. (These will be provided by teachers at the Meet the Teacher night or in the front office)
- When picking up your child in the car line, please <u>pull forward</u> until you arrive at the loading zone.
 - Students will be loaded into the first five cars in the five designated loading zones.
 - Once ALL five cars have been loaded, they will be directed to leave.
- In the car line area, students will be seated in designated grade level or sibling zones.

Front of School Grassy Area Pick up Procedures:

- Meet your child at the designated grade level cone.
- Check out with the staff member on duty.



Attendance Line


Mariposa is equipped with a computerized telephone attendance reporting system.

The absence reporting phone number is 480-541-3801 and may be called 24 hours a day.

Parents/guardians are asked to call the attendance office by 8:00a **each** day that their child is absent. Please leave a message on the voicemail indicating the student's full name, grade, date(s) of the absence and reason for the absence. If we do not receive a parent phone call, the student's absence will be recorded as a truancy.

Parents/guardians MUST call the attendance line within 24 hours of an absence, even if they spoke to the health office, or if they told a teacher.
