B-6. Student Athlete Conduct Expectations



Maryville High School Athlete Conduct Expectations

Maryville High School along with the TSSAA strives to promote participation and sportsmanship to develop good citizens through interscholastic athletics. As stated in the MHS Student Code of Ethics, "Every Rebel embodies the ideals of our school: inclusion, loyalty, academia, school spirit, honesty, integrity, and respect." Being part of a team at Maryville High School is a privilege. All athletes are expected to abide by a code of conduct affording them the honor and respect that comes from participating and competing in interscholastic athletics.

- 1) Academics
 - a) An athlete must have earned six credits the preceding school year by the first day of the new school year to be eligible for athletic participation. If ineligible for the fall semester, an athlete may become eligible for the spring semester by gaining at least three credits in the fall semester.
 - b) An athlete must maintain a passing grade in all current classes or undertaken reasonable and timely action to make amends for a failing grade or on track to raise the grade.
- 2) Attendance and Tardiness
 - a) An athlete must be present at least $\frac{1}{2}$ of the school day or two blocks in order to participate in any athletics activity on that day including but not limited to practice and games/matches.
 - b) An athlete must limit tardiness to class. The ninth tardy to school and/or to a specific class may result in a loss of participation in athletics for the remainder of the current semester.
- 3) Behavior
 - a) An athlete always maintains respect for teammates, coaches, officials, and fans.
 - b) An athlete consistently obeys behavior guidelines as set forth in the Maryville High School Student Handbook under the heading, *Student Behavior Expectations*. An athlete that has been suspended, expelled, or placed at Maryville Academy, may immediately forfeit participation in Maryville High School athletics for a length of time up to the remainder of the season when the disciplinary action ends.
 - c) An athlete refrains from unacceptable behaviors outside of the school environment including, but not exclusively, fighting, stealing, illegally using weapons, unruly behavior, bullying, sexual harassment, alcohol/drug/tobacco/vape offenses, and destruction of private or public property.
 - d) An athlete refrains from making threats against, bullying, and harassment of other students or school personnel on social media as well as posts resulting in a substantial disruption of the athletics environment.

An athlete found in violation of this code will become the subject of a meeting between the coach involved and the athletic director to determine a penalty respective to the degree of the infraction. The penalty may range from a minimum of a warning to a maximum of permanent denial of participation.
