- Choose 10 summer words and write them down. Add up each letter to find the value of the word.

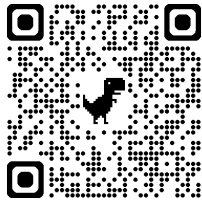
Vowels - 3 points

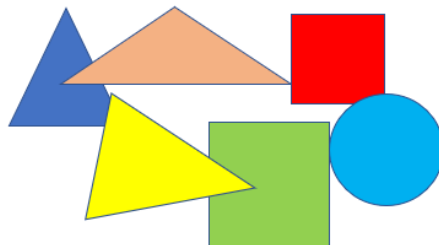


### Math

Activity Description- Two-Dimensional Shapes Drawing

#### Directions

- Design an object using only these shapes: 3 triangles, 2 squares, and 1 circle.
- Now use the same shapes to make a different drawing.

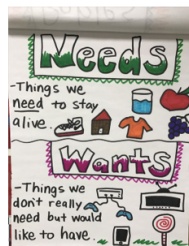


## Social Studies

### Activity Description- Needs/Wants

#### Directions

- Needs/Wants: Divide a piece of paper into 2 columns labeled NEEDS and WANTS. Illustrate (or cut pictures from magazines) at least 3 objects under each heading. Write a short paragraph telling how you might save money to buy one of the things you WANT. Some ideas might be doing chores or setting up a lemonade stand.

### Activity Description- Paper Building

#### Directions

- Use just index cards to build a tower. If you don't have index cards, try using paper, the heavier the paper the better!
- Try to make a tower that is super strong and can hold up other objects or a tower that is super tall!
- Measure your tower to see how tall it is when you've finished or see how many other objects it can hold up, like a stuffed animal, car, or book!
