
Book Swap Time at GSL!

May 1-3, Anchor Center Second Floor Lobby


We are so excited for our annual Preschool & Lower School Book Swap! Donation bins will be available to fill with your gently-used treasured books! A few details:


Lunch will be served starting at 11:15 a.m. The program will begin promptly at 11:30 a.m.


