


- As a reminder, May 22 is the last day of school for 1st-8th grade students.

# Reminders from the Nurse's Office

If your child has a history of any of the following conditions, please click the appropriate link to fill out a medical form for the 2024-25 school year.

Asthma Diabetes Food Allergies Seizures

These forms must be **updated each year per state requirements.** The form can be taken with you to your student's yearly checkup for the pediatrician to fill out this summer. If their yearly checkup has already occurred, you can drop it at your pediatrician's front desk, have the doctor fill it out, and have them call you when it is complete.



We also ask that you fill out this <u>Medication Administration Authorization Form</u> for the 2024-25 school year, if your child is on scheduled medications or if you want them to receive over-the-counter medications as needed while at school. A new form must be filled out each school year to be in compliance with state guidelines.

Any completed forms should be emailed to me or delivered to Miss Angela or myself by the first day of school on August 12. If delivered to Miss Angela, she will put them in my box in the Administrative Building.


