Laurie Branch, Board President, thanked attendees for taking the time to attend the meeting. She expressed the Board's regret at not being able to continue certain District programs and positions. She stated that revenues are down and expenses are up and that the Board is committed to offering the best possible programs for students within the District's financial constraints.

Public Comment:

David Lasky – 930 Crown Street – on behalf of the Olean Teachers' Association, congratulations were extended to the teachers' receiving tenure.

John Samuelson – 226 N. 2nd Street – thanked the Board of Education for its support in regard to his DECA competition trip. Over 10,000 students competed from all the states. John made it to the finals and brought home the "gold".

Olivia Sorokes – 301 York Street – addressed the Board of Education regarding Spanish budget cuts. Olivia is taking many college credit courses this year at OHS and may not be able to take as many next year.

Emily Sorokes – 301 York Street – addressed the Board of Education regarding Spanish. She took Spanish classes while attending OHS. She was told that students from OHS that have taken Spanish as the best Spanish students at SBU. A student needs 202 level or above classes – that is what OHS is currently offering. Emily noted that Spanish is the fasting growing language. The Spanish courses taken at OHS helped her during her semester abroad. Emily encouraged the same opportunities given to her are given to future students.

Gina Melaro – 1038 Kingston Drive – attended the Board meeting on behalf of students that were not able to attend. As a Freshman at SBU, the Spanish classes she took during her years at OHS have helped her immensely.

Sue Frentz - 422 Rock City Street, Little Valley - proposed to the Board of Education that if the District asks employees that participate in the OCSD health plan to go on their spouse's health plan, the cost savings could be used to save positions. The current OTA contract has a medical buy-out clause.

Taylor Eade – 603 Putnam Street – addressed the Board of Education regarding the reduction of the Business teacher. Taylor does not feel that abolishing Mrs. Frentz's job is a good decision. Taylor would be lost without Mrs. Frentz and her guidance. Mrs. Frentz goes out of her way for all her students. Taylor asked the Board to reconsider its decision.
