Death March of Male Auschwitz Inmates

"In their tens of thousands, from all the sub-camps of Auschwitz, the masses were dragged day and night, night and day, with no rest or break... and the Germans guarding the marchers...strew their path with gunfire. Those who lagged behind were shot, and the snow engulfed their skeletal corpses."

(Ka-Tzetnik, Salamandra)

In Auschwitz-Birkenau, more than 1,100,000 Jews, 70,000 Poles, 25,000 Sinti and Roma (Gypsies) and some 15,000 prisoners of war from the USSR and other countries were murdered.

This is not an easy story to tell, and it is a challenging production to perform and to attend, but ***Auschwitz Lullaby*** reminds us of a time in history that we must never forget if we are to prevent such an horrific event from happening again.
