- ECFE is based on the idea that parents provide their child's first and most significant learning environment and parents are children's first and most enduring teachers.
- Licensed parent educators and early childhood teachers team to make each class a welcoming, rich experience for both parents and children.
- ECFE classes are offered from birth to 5 years, with many options to fit your schedule, including evenings and Saturdays.
- All caregivers are welcome! Special grandparents, nannies, aunts, uncles and other special grown-ups can register and attend classes.

Parent Education

- Parent Education is embedded in all ECFE Classes to provide support and encouragement in your role as a parent or caregiver.
- Current research-based information on child development is standard.

Class Separation Explanation Non-Separating: The parent education component happens within the classroom so babies and toddlers stay with their caregivers.

Gradually Separating: Grown-ups and teachers begin the process slowly, being sensitive to the readiness of the children.

Separating: After beginning the class together, parents convene in a separate room for parent education and children spend time with their teacher and peers.

ECFE Classes - Sliding Fee Scale

For classes with a parent education (ECFE) component, tuition is charged on a sliding fee scale based on family household income. The price shown is the most a family would pay. All families are welcome. No one will be denied participation due to inability to pay. Class fees are calculated online.

\$40,000 - \$69,999	50% of listed price

Sibling Care Policy

Sibling care gives parents the opportunity to spend individualized time with their child in an age specific class and to fully engage during parent discussion time. If a family is taking an age specific class (examples-infants, toddlers, 2s and 3s, etc) children who are not in the age group should register for sibling care. Our sibcare room is staffed by a qualified teacher who leads age appropriate exploration, activities and play. This service is available for siblings 4 months through age 5 as part of our ECFE program. Babies under 4 months may attend any class with their family. Classes that include sibcare, are designated in the description. Register at the same time you register for your ECFE class.


Our family has truly loved our experience with Prior Lake- Savage area ECFE programming. We have found the support from other families and the parent and child educators to be invaluable.



EARLY CHILDHOOD SCREENING

Minnesota requires all children to be screened before entering public school kindergarten. The screening is most valuable soon after your child's third birthday and gives you and your child an early connection to PLSAS.

Screening is FREE and includes growth, development, and immunization checks. Your child will be assessed in preschool concepts, communication skills, motor skills and social-emotional skills.

If your child has already been screened through HeadStart, in another school district, or your own medical resource, please provide the screening report. Children only need to be screened one time. Children do not need to be screened if they have an active Individualized Education Program (IEP).

Parents can choose to conscientiously object to screening for their child. If you object, please provide a signed statement indicating your conscientious objection to screening.
