

### ENRICHMENT INFORMATION

- Adult classes are open to persons age 18 and older, unless otherwise indicated.
- Classes are funded by your fees.Classes that do not meet established minimums will have to be cancelled. **Cancellation status is** normally determined 2 business days prior to the program start date.

#### MATERIAL FEES

### **RETURNED CHECKS**

A \$25 fee will be assessed for all returned checks. Your check will no longer be accepted; pay by credit card or cash.

#### CANCELLATIONS / POSTPONEMENT

If Rochester Community Schools are closed due to weather or other emergency conditions, the Enrichment classes are also cancelled. *Whenever possible, cancelled classes will be made up. No refunds will be given if a make-up date is available. If group swim lessons are cancelled there are no make-up dates; open swim passes will be issued.* Students in the Rochester School District have priority in the use of school buildings for school functions. On occasion, classes might be relocated or suspended for a night due to building activities. We will give advance notice when possible.

### **REGISTRATION & REFUND POLICIES**

### **REGISTRATION POLICIES**

• Registration closes at 12pm two business days prior to the start of the first class (ex. classes starting Monday need to register by the prior Thursday before 12pm).

### **GENERAL REFUND POLICIES**

- A full refund will be granted for all programs cancelled by the instructor/Enrichment. If a class is adjusted as to time, dates or location by Enrichment and you cannot attend, a full refund will be issued.
- Enrollee-requested refunds requested at least 7 days prior to the start of the class will be assessed a \$10 service fee. Regardless of when you have registered.
- Enrollee-requested refunds requested 6 days or less and prior to the start of the second class will be assessed a \$25 service fee, unless otherwise noted below. Regardless of when you have registered.
- Refunds, transfers, or cancellations WILL NOT be allowed after the SECOND class has been held, regardless of attendance or sign-up date.
- Camps (programs meeting 3 days or more in the same week), Private Music Lessons, and Lifeguard Training Courses: Enrollee-requested refunds requested at least 7 days prior to the start of the program will be assessed a \$10 service fee. There will be <u>NO</u> refunds, transfers, or cancellations if requested less than 7 days prior to the program start date. Regardless of when you have registered. In addition there will be <u>NO</u> refunds on the course record fee for Lifeguard Training Courses, which is \$46.
- Substitution of participants is NOT allowed.
- Cancellations made due to an emergency will receive a pro-rated refund, minus a \$10 service fee if approved by the Enrichment Department.
- Punch cards will not be refunded or replaced for any reason, as they have no expiration date.

#### REGISTRATION INFORMATION

Registration is easy via online or on the phone. Please do not send registrations to your child's school. If you would like your child to attend a BASES class at a different school, parents are responsible for providing transportation between schools. Classes do fill quickly, so register early to avoid disappointment! **Registration closes at 12pm two business days prior to the start of the first class. There are NO late registrations**.

#### FINANCIAL AID (see page 20)

#### CLASS MAKEUP

No refunds or transfers will be given if a child cannot attend a scheduled session. In the event a class cannot be held due to an instructors absence, building/technology issue, etc. a make-up session will be added to your class schedule.

#### SNACK POLICY

Do not bring any food items of any kind to our BASES classes, unless medically necessary and approved by the Enrichment department prior to the program start date.

#### LATE PICKUP

Children cannot walk home from BASES classes. You must be on time to pick-up children. BASES cannot guarantee supervision after class. If parents are late picking up their child, they will be charged \$20 for the first 15 minutes, and \$10 for each 15 minutes thereafter. An invoice will be emailed and full payment must be paid prior to attending the next schduled session.






