For those of you joining us this year, welcome! For those of you returning, it is nice to have you back! We hope you have enjoyed your summer break.

The Student Center has existed on campus since 1988 via a grant from the New Jersey Department of Children and Families and provides students with confidential counseling and support services to enable them to achieve academic and personal success. Our counselors offer clinical support free of charge to any current Sussex County Technical School student. These services are different and in addition to services received from our Guidance Department.

We also offer daily recreational activities and events which are organized by our recreation coordinator and take place mainly after school in the Student Center. Students can enjoy, for free, billiards, ping-pong, foosball, video games, movies, basketball, beach volleyball, music, and time with friends. In the absence of late buses, please remember that pickup for after-school recreation is promptly at 5 pm.

Additionally, we host two annual care clinics: <u>Optical on Weds Sept 25th</u> and mobile <u>Dental on Weds Oct 9th</u>. Please see below for an interest form for those events. We also have limited financial resources to help with shop/school supplies for families who may need some assistance. Please call to determine if your request is eligible. Your call is confidential. The Student Center also offers food supplies as needed in collaboration with Sussex County Food Pantry.
