The Lehighton Area School District, located in Lehighton, Pennsylvania, 25 miles northwest of Allentown, 77 miles north of Philadelphia and 54 miles south of Scranton is a suburban school district located in Carbon County, Pennsylvania, comprised of approximately 67 square miles. The district encompasses the borough of Lehighton, Franklin Township, East Penn Township, Mahoning Township and Weissport Borough with a population of approximately 20,000.

The district provides a Pre-K program which offers concentrated support to early learners, as well as a full day kindergarten program to all students. The district provides a full complement of clubs and extracurricular activities,

including many music, drama and theater offerings. FBLA, Honor Societies, Video Production Club, Aevidum and Science Olympiad are just a sampling of the district's offerings. Additionally, the district hosts a full schedule of athletic opportunities for its students.

Lehighton Area School District emphasizes basic skills and equal opportunities as the foundation for their educational programs. The district employs approximately 158 professional staff as well as 96 support staff that work closely with the student body.

The district has an operating budget of \$50.5 million.
