ELECTIONS POLICIES AND PROCEDURES GUIDE

Introduction

This *Elections Policy and Procedures* guide will give everyone in the Cologne Academy community information on the Cologne Academy School Board election. The election is important for Cologne Academy, as parents and staff consider the strategic needs of the school. Informed voting makes a difference.

Board of Directors Composition

The Board of Directors consists of seven (7) members who are elected by the parents and staff of the school. The Board consists of accomplished people who represent one or more of the following constituencies: Cologne Academy teacher; Cologne Academy parent; and community member. Cologne's bylaws require that it have at least one person from each of these three groups on the Board at all times. Currently, the Board is made up of one teacher member, five parent members, and one community member. There are three seats up for election this year, with at least one being held by a teacher member and one by a community member.

The Overall Function of the Board

Board members have both a legal duty and an ethical obligation to ensure that Cologne Academy carries out its mission, vision, and goals. As stated in our charter approved by the State of Minnesota, our mission is to prepare students for academic success through excellence in literacy by integrating the Core Knowledge Sequence and create a content-rich learning environment that prepares K-8 children to achieve their best as students and as people of character who will contribute skill and knowledge to their communities. The board's job is to map out the strategies that will carry Cologne Academy into its successful future.

Therefore, as part of the Board of Directors, individual board members should think of themselves as stewards of the school – responsible for the long-term viability of Cologne Academy. Whether a parent, teacher, or community member, board members do not represent particular constituencies, but rather focus on the overriding interests and welfare of the school.

Needs of the Board

In order to make sure that the board has all the skills needed to chart Cologne Academy's strategic future, we ask you to consider candidates that would fulfill several existing needs on the board.

- Experience in governance (includes financial management and leadership)
- Experience in human relations (includes people management)
- Experience in facility management (includes capital needs planning)
- Experience as an attorney (includes school and government experience, if possible)

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School Board Member Candidates and Expectations

A call for eligible candidates to complete a candidate profile will be distributed on our website and via ParentSquare no less than thirty (30 days) prior to the election. Candidate Profiles will be compiled and added to the voting guide.

Interested parties should consider the unique needs of the school board and ask themselves the following questions:

- Are you able to commit a minimum of 10 hours a month to board duties?
- Do you have experience that will be beneficial to our school?
- Can you represent the needs of a diverse student body and school community?
- Will you lead with a high degree of ethics and integrity?
- Do you believe in the mission and vision of Cologne Academy?
- Will you work to enhance our school's commitment to living out the mission and vision in our community?

Election Dates and Voting Procedures

The Cologne Academy election for board members is scheduled every spring. Here's what you can expect:

- A voting guide introducing the candidates who are running for positions for the Cologne Academy School Board will be distributed on our website and via ParentSquare at least ten (10) days prior to the election.
- ELECTION DAY!
 - The official election will be open via ParentSquare one week prior to the official election date.
 - Each parent can vote once via ParentSquare.
 - One person cannot cast 2 votes. Each vote has a unique signature login. If there are 2 votes from one account, only the first time-stamped vote will be counted.
 - If you would like an absentee ballot, please contact the office at least three days prior to the election date.
 - All votes must be cast no later than 4:00 p.m. on the date of the election.

School Board Election Results

The results of the election will be presented to and approved by the current Board of Directors at the Cologne Academy School Board meeting following the election. The results will then be announced to the Cologne Academy community via ParentSquare and on our website.
