SUPERINTENDENT'S REPORT

- Dr. Young noted the success of recent events including the Brownwood High School Graduation and the First Annual End-of-Year Awards. Young congratulated BHS Principal, Mitch Moore and his staff for the work done coordinating the commencement ceremony and acknowledged his appreciation for the Brownwood Education Foundation that sponsored the End-of-Year Staff Awards. A billboard featuring the elementary and secondary teachers of the year has been designed and will be on display in the coming weeks.
- Upcoming maintenance summer projects include the following:
 - Woodland Heights Elementary
 - New awning to bus drop-off and pick-up area
 - New fence around the track
 - East Elementary
 - New ceiling in the main hallway
 - New door to playground
 - New fence around play area for added security
 - Brownwood High School
 - Work on entryway doors and security
 - Front desk configuration
 - Northwest Elementary
 - Improvements to the outdoor front entrance area
 - Brownwood Intermediate School and Coggin Elementary
 - Awning to be power-washed
 - Fence repairs
- Technology upgrades are on schedule, with new equipment arriving to be installed.
- The five new busses that were recently ordered by the district have arrived and will be ready for service during the new school-year.
- In regards to the recent STAAR testing issues, Dr. Young reported that Brownwood ISD will continue the summer programs for students who need remediation, and thanked Charles Chesser and Bryan Allen for their work coordinating summer school programs. ESL, Attendance Recovery, and Credit Make-up programs will also continue as planned. The additional STAAR remediation will finish up this week due to the cancellation of next weeks scheduled tests. The district was also notified by TEA that STAAR score results from Spring testing (3rd-8th) which were expected to arrive this week have now been postponed until July.

DISCUSSION & ACTION ITEMS

DISCUSSION: David McCullough, Brownwood ISD Alternative Programs Director, DTC, provided the board and overview of the student handbooks. Few changes were needed, and they included updates to Compulsory Attendance and requests for Special Education video equipment. The student handbooks are presented on an annual basis. The Texas Association of School Boards provides the updated document each year, insuring that it complies with all state and federal laws.

DISCUSSION: The board was provided with the current District Mission and Goals for review. Yearly in February, the Board works on the District Mission and Goals at its annual Board Retreat. These drive the work of the District and provide guidance for staff, students, and community.

ACTION ITEM: The 2016-2017 Student Code of Conduct was presented for approval. This annual approval is required by the state. The Texas Association of School Boards provides the updated document each year, insuring that it complies with all laws on student discipline. No changes or updates were required by the state this year. David McCullough noted that a Spanish version will be available, in addition to the English version. Tim Jacobs made a motion to accept the 2016-2017 Code of Conduct, as presented. Roderick Jones seconded and the motion passed unanimously.

ACTION ITEM: An updated Teacher Appraisal Calendar that contains the correct dates, schedules and information for the 2016-2017 school-year was provided to the board for consideration. Eric Evans made a motion to approve the calendar as presented. Dr. Lisa Fowler seconded and the motion passed unanimously.

ACTION ITEM: The list of 2016-2017 T-TESS Certified Appraisers for Brownwood ISD was updated for the board to consider with the noted removal of Joe Cardenas, who has retired. Tim Jacobs made a motion for approval and Roderick Jones seconded. The motion passed unanimously.

CONSENT AGENDA: Items on the Consent Agenda were approved unanimously as presented, with a motion by Tim Jacobs and a second by Roderick Jones.
