

Background Check Forms Instructions

Volunteers

Thank you for volunteering to help the University of Detroit Jesuit High School and Academy in its mission to *Develop Men for Others*. Your help is greatly appreciated and of great value to the school.

There is a required background check for all volunteers at the school. The background check requires completion and submission of **all** the following documents (**Note – the background check will not be conducted by the school unless all the below documents are included and submitted at the same time. Incomplete submissions or submissions missing information will not be returned, but will be destroyed**):

1. Archdiocese of Detroit *Certificate of Completion of Protecting God's Children* course. Volunteers may obtain this certificate by registering for a training session at virtus.org.
2. Praesidium *Acknowledgment and Authorization*
 - This document captures all the information necessary to conduct the Praesidium background check. It must be completed in full. **Your social security number must be included on the *Acknowledgement and Authorization* form.**
3. Praesidium *Disclosure Regarding Background Investigation*
4. University of Detroit Jesuit High School and Academy *Conviction Disclosure Form*
 - This document requires disclosure of convictions of certain offenses as described in the document. If not convicted of any of these offenses, circle 1. If convicted of one of these offenses, circle 2. and provide an explanation.
5. Government photo identification
 - Driver license, passport, etc.

Hard copies of all the above documents must be returned to the Director of Security at the school. **Background check documents may not be submitted electronically; documents may not be submitted via email.**

ACKNOWLEDGMENT AND AUTHORIZATION

Randol Mill Rd., Suite 630, Arlington, TX, 76011, 800-743-6354, the Company itself, and/or a related third-party entity only if I am being considered for a direct or temporary engagement with or by them. I agree that a facsimile ("fax") or electronic or photographic copy of this Authorization shall be as valid as the original.

State of Washington applicants and employees only: You have the right to receive a complete and accurate disclosure of the nature and scope of any investigative consumer report as well as a written summary of your rights and remedies under Washington law.

Massachusetts and New Jersey applicants and employees only: You have the right to inspect and promptly receive a copy of any investigative consumer report requested by the Company by contacting the consumer reporting agency identified above directly.

New York applicants and employees only: You have the right to inspect and receive a copy of any investigative consumer report requested by the Company by contacting the consumer reporting agency identified above directly. By signing below, you also acknowledge receipt of Article 23-A of the New York Correction Law.

Minnesota applicants and employees only: You have the right, upon written request to Agency, to receive a complete and accurate disclosure of the nature and scope of any consumer report. Agency must make this disclosure within five days of receipt of your request or of Company's request for the report, whichever is later. Please check this box if you would like to receive a copy of a consumer report if one is obtained by the Company. ☐

DISCLOSURE REGARDING BACKGROUND INVESTIGATION

University of Detroit Jesuit High School and Academy

(“the Company”) may obtain information about you from a consumer reporting agency for purposes of employment, volunteer positions, work performed under contract, retention, or reassignment (hereafter known as your “engagement”). Thus, you may be the subject of a “consumer report” and/or an “investigative consumer report” which may include information about your character, general reputation, personal characteristics, and/or mode of living, and which can involve personal interviews with sources such as your neighbors, friends or associates. These reports may contain information regarding your criminal history, credit history, motor vehicle records (“driving records”), verification of your education or employment history or other background checks. You have the right, upon written request made within a reasonable time after receipt of this notice, to request disclosure of the nature and scope of any investigative consumer report. Please be advised that the nature and scope of the most common form of investigative consumer report obtained with regard to applicants for employment is an investigation into your education and/or employment history conducted by Praesidium, 2225 E. Randol Mill Rd., Suite 630, Arlington, TX, 76011, 800-743-6354, or another outside organization. You should carefully consider whether to exercise your right to request disclosure of the nature and scope of any investigative consumer report.

ATTACHMENT 1
LISTED OFFENSES

Accosting, enticing, or soliciting a child for immoral purposes.

Involvement in child sexually abusive activity or material.

A third or subsequent violation of any combination of engaging in obscene or indecent conduct in public, indecent exposure, or a local ordinance substantially corresponding to either offense.

First, second, third, or fourth degree Criminal Sexual Conduct (CSC).

Assault with intent to commit CSC.

If the victim is less than 18 years of age, the crime of gross indecency (except for juvenile disposition or adjudication), kidnapping, sodomy, or soliciting another for prostitution.

Leading, enticing, or carrying away a child under 14 years of age.

Pandering.

Any other violation of a state law or local ordinance constituting a sexual offense against an individual less than 18 years of age.

An offense committed by sexually delinquent person.

An attempt or conspiracy to commit one of the offenses listed above.
