Google Workspace for Education Services

Dear Parent and Guardians,

We are excited to announce that Pottsville Area School District will be using Google Workspace for Education for teachers and students. The below information (i) describes the Google Workspace services, (ii) provides links for where you can find additional information, and (iii) shares required responsibilities for students using the services. A consent form is also attached. As with any educational endeavor, a strong partnership with families is essential to a successful experience.

I. What is Google Workspace for Education?

Google Workspace for Education is a free web-based suite of applications for schools to use. Students and teachers can create, share and store documents online to collaborate on projects and turn in assignments electronically. Students will have access to the Google Workspace “Core Services”.

- Google Drive – 30 GB cloud-based storage for files
- Google Docs Editors – a word processing, spreadsheet, and presentation toolset similar to Microsoft Office
- Google Calendar – online calendar to organize schedules, daily activities, assignments
- Google Email (Gmail) – managed by the School District’s Technology Department. Student emails will not be made public, nor will Google be provided any personal information.

Examples of student use includes showcasing class projects, building an electronic portfolio of school learning experiences, and working in small collaborative groups on presentations to share with others.

Google Workspace for Education also offers “Additional Services” (YouTube and Maps) that some students may have access to use. These services are designed for consumer users and can be optionally used with Google Workspace for Education accounts if allowed for educational purposes by the School District’s administrator and appropriate consent is obtained.

Benefits of Google Workspace for Education?

- Anytime, anywhere access – Google Workspace for Education works in any web browser, on any computer, which means users can access their documents, calendars, and email from school, at home, or anywhere there is Internet access.
- Students have the ability to use and experience current technology applications and tools.
- Google Workspace for Education allows for easy collaboration among students and teachers.
- Teachers have the ability to be involved via technology throughout the whole assignment process by providing comments and feedback directly in student documents.

III. Guidelines for Responsible Use of G-Suite for Education by Students:

- **Official Email Address:** All students will use a username@ctide.net account in order to use Google Workspace for Education. Email account descriptions for K-12 are **below***.
- **Prohibited Conduct:** Please refer to the School District's Acceptable Use Policy at: <https://go.boarddocs.com/pa/pott/Board.nsf/Public?open&id=policies#>.
- **Access Restriction:** Access to and use of Google Workspace for Education is considered a privilege accorded at the discretion of the School District. The School District maintains the right to immediately withdraw the access and use of these services, including email when there

is reason to believe that violations of the law or School District policies have occurred. In such cases, the alleged violation will be referred to a Site Administrator for further investigation and adjudication.

- **Security:** The School District cannot guarantee the security of electronic files located on Google's systems. Although Google states that it does have a powerful content filter in place for email, the School District cannot assure that users will not be exposed to unsolicited information.
- **Privacy:** The School District and all electronic users should treat electronically stored information in individual's accounts/files as confidential and private. However, users of student email and the Internet are strictly prohibited from accessing files and information other than their own. The School District reserves the right to access the username@ctide.net Google systems when there is reasonable suspicion that unacceptable use has occurred.

Email Account Information*:

- All students in grades K-4 will be able to send and receive emails INSIDE the School District only.
- All students in grades 5-12 will have access to both (1) a Google Workspace for Education account and (2) an Internet email account that can send and receive email from INSIDE AND OUTSIDE the School District.
- Under the Family Education Rights and Privacy Act (FERPA), some students' information is required to be restricted from disclosure to third parties, unless a legal exception exists or consent is given from the parent, or from a student who has reached the age of 18.
- Students must use email accounts for curriculum and instructional purposes only.

- NO**, I do not give my permission for my child to be assigned a School District Google Workspace for Education account. This means my child will NOT receive Google Workspace for Education "Core Services" and "Additional Services," including an email account.
