## Advanced Academics Parent/Student Agreement

**Instruction:** Read the agreement, complete this form and submit it to your counselor on your scheduled registration date.

**Enrollment in an Honors/AP course will NOT be allowed without the submission of this form.** It is **strongly recommended** that the students(s) and the parent(s) attend an informational session with the campus counselor during beginning of year registration.

**All students and parents of those students who wish to register for an Honors (Hnrs) or Advanced Placement (AP) course must sign the following agreement. Signatures affirm that:**

1. Parent and student agree that the student meets the prerequisites and has the skills and tenacity for the class(es):
  - a. Prospective honors students are recommended to have earned an "A" grade for the previous two semesters in a non-honors course or have received an "A" or "B" in honors coursework for the previous two semesters.
  - b. Students are strongly recommended to have met state standards on EOC assessments.
  - c. Demonstrate increased independence and take on a high degree of responsibility.
  - d. Meet higher standards than students in non-Honors/AP to earn the same grade.
  - e. Spend as much as 1 ½ - 2 hours of homework each night per class. \* Please take this into consideration when enrolling in multiple AP/Honors classes.
  - f. Commit to completing any required summer work on time and in a satisfactory manner.
  - g. Commit to remain enrolled in the class(es) for the entire school year.
  - h. Take the AP exam for the corresponding course in May. **A student who fails to take the corresponding AP exam will lose AP weighted credit, and receive Honors weighted credit for the class.** Currently, all AP exams are paid for by SRISD.
  - i. Uphold the school's academic integrity policy. A student may be dropped from the class(es) if cheating, plagiarism, or work not personally completed by the student is submitted.
 

\*Other consequences may occur depending on circumstance.
2. While transfers to an Honors/AP class may be granted the following policy will apply:
  - a. For students that did not pre-register for an AP/Honors Class, scheduling into an AP/Honors class will only take place during the first 2 weeks of the fall semester.
    - i. All students that are scheduled into an AP/Honors class within the first 2 weeks of the fall semester will be required to complete the summer assignment for the class by the end of the 3<sup>rd</sup> week of the 1<sup>st</sup> six weeks grading period.
  - b. Parent/student may request a transfer within the first 2 weeks of the fall and spring semester.
3. While transfers OUT of an Honors/AP class to a non-Honors/AP class may be granted the following policy will apply:
  - a. Teachers may request a student be transferred within the first 2 weeks of the fall and spring semester, if the student does not display behavior consistent with the behaviors outlined in **1.a thru 1.i** above.
  - b. All transfer requests will result in a parent/student/teacher/counselor conference. **Permission to transfer will be granted only if space is available.**
  - c. Grades earned in the Honors/AP class(es) will be transferred to the non-Honors/AP class(es), when appropriate.
