



## LEGACY H.S. DRESS AND GROOMING STANDARDS

Legacy High School standards are aligned with WFISD rules regarding dress and grooming. These standards are in effect from the time the student arrives on the school campus until the student leaves the school campus each day. The campus includes the building and grounds. The dress code also applies to students who are representing LHS as a part of a school group or organization outside the regular school day.

Students who are not in compliance with dress code standards will be asked to change. If they do not have an appropriate change of clothing, students will be permitted to call a parent for a change of clothes. Dress code infractions cannot be covered up with jackets, sweaters, sweatshirts, etc. If a student cannot obtain appropriate clothing, they will be placed in ISS.

- Appropriate undergarments shall be worn and appropriately covered.
- Sunglasses, combs, hats, bandanas, hoodies, and any other head coverings shall not be worn in the buildings.
- Head coverings worn for religious or medical reasons may be allowed. Potential exemptions shall be filed with the principal by the parent and shall be handled on an individual basis.
- When belts are worn, they must be buckled. If there is no buckle, the belt must be tied.
- Shirts and blouses must be buttoned. No skin may show between the bottom of shirt and top of pants, shorts, skirts.
- Clothing or accessories with lettering, symbols or decorations that detract from the learning process or illustrate or promote alcoholic beverages, tobacco products, sex, vulgarity or violence either explicitly or by innuendo will not be allowed.
- T-shirts, hats, tattoos and other articles bearing words or symbols, color combinations or any other recognized gang insignia, articles of clothing or uniforms, will not be allowed.
- Shoes are to be worn at all times (no house shoes). Shoes designed for strings or buckles must be fully laced/fastened. Students shall not wear shoes that the principal determines to be a hazard.
- Students will not attend classes with hair rolled up nor will they apply makeup in the classroom.
- Hair is to be neat, clean, well-groomed and styled so that vision will not be obstructed. If beards or mustaches are worn, they must be kept clean and neatly trimmed.
- Students are permitted to wear earrings in their ears only. All other body piercings are not allowed.
- All dress, skirt, and short lengths must fall no higher than 3 inches above the knee.
- Clothing with spaghetti straps will not be permitted.
- Holes in jeans may not be higher than 3 inches above the knee. If holes are higher than 3 inches above the knee, leggings, tights or shorts must be worn under jeans covering skin.
- Short shorts, bare midriffs, halter tops, tank tops, see through tops, tight fitting warm-up/jogging suits, sun dresses, miniskirts, and sagging pants are prohibited. Leggings/yoga pants may be worn as long as tops are long enough to cover the bottom.
- Students may not wrap themselves in a blanket while at school. Blankets must be folded and stored in a backpack until school is out.
