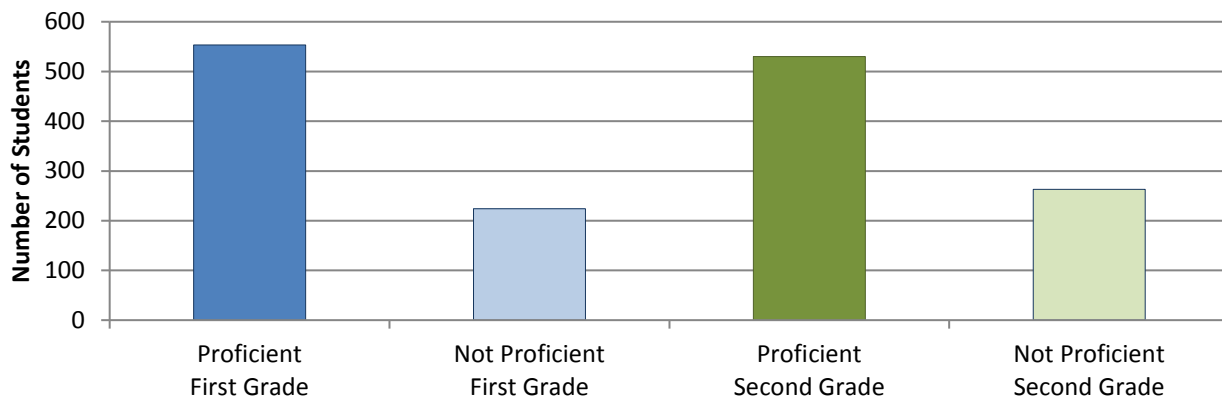

Read to Achieve is an accountability program required by the State of North Carolina for the purpose of ensuring students are reading on grade level by the end of third grade. Districts are monitoring proficiency of First and Second Graders as part of this effort in order to support students in their reading development.

At the end of 2017-18, 71.2 percent of First Graders and 66.8 percent of Second Graders were reading on grade level as measured on the mCLASS literacy assessment.
