***Please note: 3-year-old and full-day students are not eligible for transportation.**

Please note: Full-day 3-year-old and 4-year-old preschool require registration through Eleyo. For 4-year-olds, this is in addition to the district enrollment listed in the half day instructions. 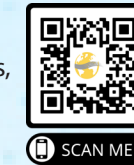

AM SESSION	Monday - Thursday Mornings 8:15 a.m. - 11 a.m. 9 monthly payments of \$340/mo or \$3,060 annually
PM SESSION	Monday - Thursday Afternoons: 12 p.m. - 2:45 p.m. 9 monthly payments of \$340/mo or \$3,060 annually

Fridley Public Schools is proud to offer a 4-Star Parent Aware rated preschool program to help prepare your child for school success.

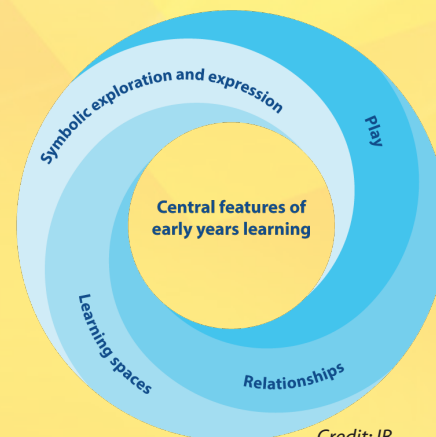
High-quality and Aligned Curriculum

SCHEDULE YOUR CHILD'S EARLY CHILDHOOD SCREENING

An **early childhood screening** is required by Minnesota Statutes prior to entrance into public school. Screenings are conducted at the Fridley Community Center (6085 7th Street NE) throughout the year.
