will provide services to include: GED and college prep; vocational and skill building; job readiness and coaching; evidence-based life skills; educational tutoring and computer lab; family engagement activities; parenting workshops; student advocacy; and case management and referrals. Our goal is to help adolescents build strong community supports; increase their positive mental health and wellness; and learn effective tools for substance use, recovery, and refusal.
