

# Exceptional Student Education Eligibility for Students Who Are Deaf or Hard of Hearing Timeline

## (Rule 6A-6.03013, F.A.C.)



\*“If either of these assessments provides sufficient information to determine that a student who is deaf or hard of hearing is eligible for exceptional student education, the other assessment must be waived for the purpose of determining eligibility. However, if the assessment is waived because it was not necessary to determine eligibility, the assessment must be completed during the IEP process [within 30 days].” (Rule 6A-6.03013, F.A.C.)
