JOB DESCRIPTION

CLINICAL NURSING INSTRUCTOR

QUALIFICATIONS:

1. Hold a clear, active Florida license to practice either practical nursing or professional nursing, have at least 1 year of clinical experience, and one of the following:
 - a. Have completed a course in teaching adults or
 - b. Have at least 1 year of experience in teaching adults, or
 - c. Have at least 1 year experience in supervising nursing assistants.

REPORTS TO: Principal and Director of Curriculum & Instruction

JOB GOAL

To facilitate the certified nurse assisting program and follow the curriculum framework established by the Department of Education which shall include material that will provide a basic level of knowledge and demonstrable skills for each student completing the program.

SUPERVISES: NA

PERFORMANCE RESPONSIBILITIES:

1. Providing standardized curriculum to include a minimum of 40 hours of clinical instruction.
2. Participating in the planning of each learning experience,
3. Ensuring that course objectives/outcomes are accomplished,
4. Requiring a grade of 70% or greater on all theoretical examinations,
5. Requiring a passing grade for satisfactory completion of all skills evaluations,
6. Ensuring that students do not perform activities for which they have not received instruction and in which they have not been found competent,
7. Supervising and evaluating students giving care to clients in clinical areas,
8. Providing direct supervision in the classroom and in clinical experiences; and
9. Monitoring health care professionals who assist in providing program instruction.
10. Clinical simulations shall consist of activities or events replicating clinical practice using scenarios via two or more of the following: manikins, standardized patients, role playing, skills stations or computer based critical thinking situations.
11. Clinical simulation shall also include pre-briefing and debriefing didactic education.
12. Prior to any direct contact with a resident, a training program shall require that a student receive a minimum of 16 hours of classroom instruction in

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communication and interpersonal skills; infection control; safety/emergency procedures including the Heimlich maneuver, promoting residence's independence; and respecting resident's rights.

PHYSICAL REQUIREMENTS:

- Medium Work: Exerting up to 50 pounds of force occasionally, and/or up to 20 pounds of force frequently and/or up to 10 pounds of force as needed to move objects.

TERMS OF EMPLOYMENT: Salary shall be paid consistent with the District's approved compensation plan for the position. Length of the work year and hours of employment shall be those established by the District.

EVALUATION:

Performance of this job will be evaluated in accordance with provisions of the School Board's policy on evaluation of personnel.
