Completing a Financial Aid Application is now a graduation requirement.



Texas Success Initiative: (TSIA2) College Readiness

It is a college readiness requirement for all Texas Public Colleges/Universities/Technical Schools.

Colleges suggest taking ASAP in order to be ready for the first available orientation and registration dates.

TSIA2 Math College Ready Scores:

CRC 950 - 990

OR

CRC 910 – 949 AND Diagnostic Level 6

TSIA2 ELAR College Ready Scores:

CRC 945 - 990 **AND** Essay 5 - 8

OR

CRC 910 – 944 **AND** Diagnostic Level 5 – 6 **AND** Essay 5 – 8

TSI Exemptions	
ACT -Taken before February 15, 2023	 English Language Arts & Reading (ELAR) - composite score of 23 AND 19 or higher. Math - composite score of 23 AND 19 or higher.
ACT -Taken after February 15, 2023	 English Language Arts & Reading (ELAR) - combined score of 40 on the English and Reading tests. There is no composite score. Math - score of 22 on the Math test. There is no composite score.
SAT	 English Language Arts Reading (ELAR) – 480 or above on EBRW Math – 530 or above on Math

- O Range for Scores: 400-1600
- Calculator allowed on the entire test

ACT/ACT online

- O Scale Score: 1-36
- O 4 test (optional Essay)
- O 2 hours 55 minutes
- O 215 Questions
- Free online Test Prep for fee wavier students through Kaplan or ACT Academy for Everyone
- 4 Reading Passages
- O Science Section
- O Calculator on all math questions
- O ACT test questions are directly related to what students learn in most of their high school courses.

As a junior, the choices you make on your senior curriculum are important, not because of 'how it looks to colleges', rather, 'how will these courses prepare you for the expectations and realities of the college curriculum'.

*Consider taking AP Courses, Dual Credit, or Dual Enrollment Courses

*Make sure you have taken all graduation requirements

Dual Credit - allows students to simultaneously earn high school and college credit by successfully completing the course (most of these classes are online and we have a few taught by a BHS teacher)

Some of the courses offered:

- English 1301/1302
- College Math and Science Courses
- Government/Economics

Students must take the TSIA 2 assessment and meet specific requirements to enroll.

Things to remember:

o Dual Credit Courses can be taken from **Ranger College** or **Howard Payne**

- b BHS Pays for dual credit courses taken during the school year.
- A grade of a 60 will get you high school credit but may not give you college credit.
- Anything below a 60 factors into your GPA as a zero.

Dual Enrollment - allows students to earn high school and potentially earn college credit while still in high school. A high school grade and college grade are given. The student <u>does not</u> have to take the college credit. You must make a 70 or higher to get HS credit. (Same with the college credit.)


