- Certified administration: 5%
- Certified teaching staff with attached career ladder adjustments
- Office staff: 5%
- Gayla Fleming & Del Shelden: 8%
- Increase the extra class stipend to \$8000
- *Increase all activity stipends* 5%
- Glenn Mabile additional 2 weeks of paid vacation per year and 5% pay increase
- Hiring of one new custodian and office staff member
