

## **BEFORE taking DUAL CREDIT, do some research:**

If you do not know for sure which university/college you are attending or do not have an idea of a degree plan, then know that you are taking a gamble as to whether the course will transfer.

You can however, check the **Texas Common Course Numbering System** below to check course transferability.

1. Go to the Texas Common Course Numbering System <http://www.tccns.org>  
Click-- "Compare Schools." Scroll down and choose from which school the dual credit will be earned such as Howard Payne University, Ranger College, University of Texas, or Texas State Technical College.
2. Then choose the university/college you think you may attend upon graduation.
3. The first column is the TCCNS course name listed alphabetically; scroll down to find a specific course, and if the course name is listed in all three columns, the course **WILL TRANSFER**. If it is NOT listed in all three columns, it will not transfer.
4. To research even further, go to a specific college/university website and in the search engine on the main web page, search a specific degree plan; for example, type in "accounting degree plan." It should direct you to a link where you can find that specific degree plan.
