Just a few things to remember about the bus services this year:

- 1.) The bus fleet is new and we need your students to help keep them clean and ready to transport students.
- 2.) Bus route numbers have changed so please double check that your student is getting on the right bus.
- 3.) School bell times have changed so please make sure your student is at the bus stop on time.
- 4.) Bus pick-up/drop-off times are approximate, please show up at your stop 10 minutes before your assigned time. Please remember we have a lot of students to transport and we need everyone to do their part to meet the bus on time. Due to the new bell schedule we will not be able to call buses back for students who miss their buses.
- 5.) All students will have an ID card and we need them to scan on and off the bus each time they ride. Please attach the ID card in a location that is easy for the student to get to such as a lanyard or hung low on their backpacks.
- 6.) Seatbelts will be worn by all students, not wearing them is a safety risk. Failure to wear seatbelts will result in your student not being able to ride the bus.
- 7.) All students must remain seated throughout the bus route. Moving around the bus while it is in motion is a major safety risk.
- 8.) Food and drinks are not allowed on the buses. Please remind your students not to eat or drink anything while they are on the bus.

- 9.) Writing or drawing on the seats and intentional seat damage is not allowed. Damage to our new seats will result in discipline up to the student being removed from the bus and the parent could share in the cost of the repairs.
- 10.) **Arguing with bus drivers or monitors is not allowed.** Please contact our office if you or your student has an issue with the bus services or personnel. We want to provide you both with exemplary service and would like to address any issue in the best way possible.
- 11.) Please be sure to **download our ParentView App** so that you can get route updates and notifications. You may also track where your student's bus is in its route to better estimate the arrival time. Please see the Lake Worth Website for more information about the ParentView App.

Please make sure that your student understands these rules and that they are ready to ride the bus in a safe and courteous manner. Students that do not obey the bus rules and cause discipline or safety concerns will not be allowed to ride the bus.
