### Helpful Scholarship Tips



- Read the eligibility requirements carefully along with the deadline dates
- Download the [Senior Brag Sheet](#) - fill it out and give it to teachers, a counselor or anyone who may be writing a letter of recommendation for you. **Most scholarships require two or three letters of recommendation**
- Organize your applications, your parent's financial information, your test scores, transcripts, and letters of recommendation, and anything else that is requested
- Follow scholarship instructions and make sure that your application is legible. Proofread your application, or have someone do it for you, and also make a copy of your application for your records.
- Remember to thank your recommenders for the time they invest in writing an amazing letter of recommendation for you!
