- 2. Principal:
 - a) Reopening plans
 - (1) Results from parent commitment forms, 594 forms received thus far (one family not responding out of protest).
 - (2) Kinder, 1st, 2nd, 3rd predominance of students who selected hybrid, 4th and 5th grade higher concentration who want distance learning
 - b) Question about families possibly pulling children from school to homeschool completely
 - c) Next steps:
 - (1) Form does not mean school is coming back.
 - (2) Going through and tagging each kid to match each response to a teacher to better understand number break down per class
 - (a) Determine which of these students are signed up for ATB, Boys & Girls Clubs, and other childcare programs, hope is to put those children in the morning session.
 - (b) Determining kids with siblings at Roosevelt or other Burbank schools to better coordinate schedules

- (c) Tagging kids with special education services, especially SEC students.
- (d) Look at what these distance learning and hybrid classes look like, trying to create as little change as necessary
- (e) Combination classes may need to be created to accommodate needs per grade
- (f) Hoping plan is finalized before winter break

- A. Review of 2020-2021 School Plan Motion for approval, seconded, minutes approved and passed. None opposed.
 - 1. Last year's plan was never able to be fully implemented or evaluated due to COVID-19 disruption.
 - 2. Guidance is to continue goals that we had last year.
 - 3. Enrollment will stay at around 600
 - 4. CAASPP not given in 2019-2020.

- 5. Overall performance: Language Arts, Suspension: ranked in blue, Math: ranked green, Chronic Absenteeism: ranked orange (low)
- 6. State testing is required to receive federal funding, testing is being required for this school year. CA is paring down the SPAC testing, though there are security challenges with the test. Shooting for compliance with the test. LPAC test was a success.
