These are **recommendations** in the event that students and staff may return to school.

#### **Debbie**

- Harvard Risk Reduction for Reopening Schools - note that there are many suggestions there that we have already looked into. Suggests that everyone review it to see if there are any additional ideas.

#### **Health & Safety:**

- Locker rooms should not be used; difficult to maintain distance
- Outside play is encouraged as long as it doesn't involve students being close to each other
- Protocol for students exhibiting Covid-like symptoms will follow public health guidelines; this will be made clear to parents.
- Quarantining parameters will come from public health guidelines.
- BUSD already has procedures for infectious disease and those apply to Covid and will be followed.
- If a child is sent home with Covid-like symptoms, parent will be encouraged to contact the child's physician and get a note if the child has a non-communicable illness (like allergies).
- Students who return from illness and/or quarantine will be checked on by health office.

#### **Nutrition Services:**

- Food services has plans for distributing food in any instructional model.
- Preference on hybrid model is to distribute food once a week (perhaps Friday).
- Food services is ready to address any changes.

#### **Facilities:**

- Markers on floor to maintain distancing
- Limit number of students in a restroom
- Locker rooms - MS not using them, HS still reviewing
- Supplies like hand sanitizer, classroom and office cleaning supplies, etc., are being ordered and stored in the warehouse. Sites should get their supplies from Facilities and not order their own.

#### **Technology infrastructure:**

- Tech team is working on being able to possibly stream class lectures
- Computers should be cleaned by being wiped down with proper products, no sprays.

- UV device cleaner has been procured. It is very slow (15 minute per device) and therefore not practical to use widely across the district.
