Donations for Auditorium Renovations Continued

Estimated costs for auditorium work are:

• Removal of existing seats:	\$ 4,500
• Fabrication and installation of new seats:	\$ 60,000
• Repair of wooden floors:	\$ 3,100
• Replacement of carpeting:	\$ 7,000
• Installation of motorized front/read projection screen	\$ 7,000
• Refinishing of wood on the stage and the steps	\$ 4,200
TOTAL:	\$ 85,800

As of the end of October 2019, we have raised about \$12,900 for this work.

We still need to raise \$72,900 to renovate our auditorium.
