

## **Donations for Performing Arts**

Over the years, we have seen how the arts have made a positive impact on our students' lives. This is why we continue to provide our students with as many opportunities as we can to explore the arts whether it be in visual arts, theatre, dance, media, and/or music.

It is our belief that every student at Miller Elementary School should have access to a high-quality, standards-based sequential arts education program.

We believe that our school's successes can be attributed to a well-rounded arts education program and that we can use the arts to develop the whole child not only academically but also socially and emotionally.

Funds would be used to hire artists to provide workshops to students in Dance, Media Arts, Music (Transitional Kindergarten, Kindergarten, and Grade 1), Theatre, and Visual Arts.

For 2019 – 2020, students will receive the following performing arts workshops:

### **Dance Workshops:**

- 1 - Transitional Kindergarten Class at 6 workshops = \$640
- 5 - Kindergarten Classes at 6 workshops = \$3,200
- 5 - Grade 3 Classes at 6 workshops = \$3,200

### **Theatre workshops:**

- 5 - Grade 1 Classes at 7 workshops = \$3,200
- 5 - Grade 2 Classes at 7 workshops = \$3,200
- 4 - Grade 4 Classes at 8 workshops = \$2,400
- 4 - Grade 5 Classes at 8 workshops = \$2,400
