

# Theatre Arts (6<sup>th</sup> Grade Full Year)

Scope and Sequence 2024-2025

*Course Description: This full year theatre arts program in 6<sup>th</sup> grade will provide an opportunity for students to explore and develop skills in creative dramatics. Classroom activities include mime/pantomime, improvisation, characterization, technical theatre (including: scenery, lighting, sound, costuming, hair/makeup), and play production. Emphasis will be placed on a variety of in-class performances and individual / group presentations. Students may have the opportunity to audition for productions and / or participate in Theatre Arts tournaments. These events will require additional preparation and involvement after school, and on Saturdays.*
