The behavior response rubric is an essential tool used to ensure systematic and aligned adult responses to student behavior.

Consequences will be integrated with restorative practices:

Restorative Practices shift the conversation between school staff and students to offer an opportunity for all people affected by an action to have dialogue about how to make things right and restore the classroom community

*It is a school wide expectation that every classroom teacher documents which incident step a student is on using this rubric.

Yellow: Teacher Handled

Blue: Principal Handled

Some codes denoted with an *asterisk*are only able to be entered by the principal. IMPORTANT: Enter *code in the <u>incident description</u> of the referral and select closest viable code option so it can be entered in Skyward. The principal will appropriately recode the behavior.

Seven unexcused absences in a school year which the school considers unexcused a significant portion of the school day to begin the truancy process. A "significant portion" of the school day is determined by the school district policy.	BA Office Staff phones parent when the parent does not contact the school about their child's absence Parent must return phone call to share information regarding the student's absence to determine if it should be excused or unexcused. It is essential parents return phone calls the same day or the absences must be recorded as unexcused.	BA Office Staff will send a letter to families who have a child that has logged three unexcused absences with a reminder that BA is required by the state of Kansas to report students as truant who have 3 consecutive unexcused absences in a semester OR 5 unexcused absences in a semester OR 7 total unexcused absences in a school year.	BA Office Staff will send a letter to families once they have reached the limitations as issued by the state of Kansas' Truancy Law (stated in column two). Any additional unexcused absences would require BA to report the student as truant to the Johnson County District Attorney's Office (as part of being a state mandated reporter)	It is important to note that excessive unexcused tardies can result in unexcused absences, further resulting in truancy violations and mandated reporting. 10 tardies = 1 Unexcused absence
