Editorial Standards

In a world of omni-channel communication, presenting a unified voice for our school across all platforms requires consistent intention. Here are a few key standards:

Writing Our School Name

In the first instance, it is always preferred to use the full school name:

Mount St. Mary Catholic High School

In secondary mentions, it is acceptable to shorten the reference to:

Mount St. Mary

Alternatively, it is acceptable to shorten (however note the capitalization):

The Mount

It is acceptable to use the acronym, **MSM**

Usage of "Saint" vs. "St."

In all instances, the only acceptable usage is the abbreviation "St." - we never spell out the word "Saint" in any application.

Writing Tone

We seek to write and share about The Mount in a conversational, kind, compassionate and casual/light-hearted voice that reflects our campus culture and is grammatically accurate.

Style and Structure

In general we seek to adhere to AP Style and Structure for consistency of abbreviations, punctuation and style. If in doubt, use AP style.

Our identity.

Our new logo seeks to bridge our proud school history with The Mount family of today. The new logo includes three core elements designed to express our school's distinctives.

The Icon

Including the image of our beloved steeple ensures the cross is the highest point of our logo (the same as it is on campus) which holds deep significance to the importance of our Catholic faith.

The Name

We are proud of our Catholic education commitment - and so by including our full name in the same prominence of letters - our logo emphasizes that legacy.

The Tagline

"Leading. Serving. Living Mercy." is both our values and our vision. By including this as part of our logo, we are boldly sharing what will carry us forward and what sets apart our school family from others in our community.

School Primary Logo & Tagline

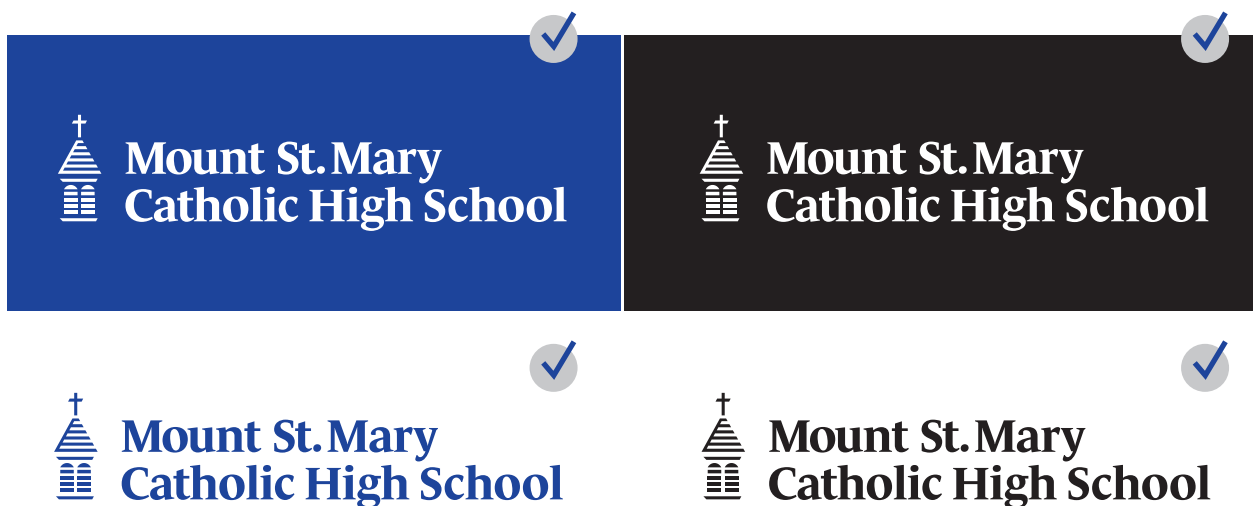
Our primary logo includes a simplification of our iconic tower of our original campus building. Due to legibility issues, it is advised to only include the tagline of the logo when it can be legible without adjusting the proportion from the original mark.



Single-color Configurations & Small Applications

There are many uses in which a single-color version of the logo would be the best or the only practical solution. In those instances, use a logo in which the icon and text are either all white, all MSM blue or MSM gray. Please do not reproduce the logo in a different color as to preserve our logo and brand equity in all uses.

In small applications where the tagline would not be legible, DO NOT adjust the tagline size, instead simply use an alternative version of the logo that does not include the tagline in the case of a small application.



Logo Usage

It is important to preserve the equity of our brand identity by ensuring we use it consistently in all applications.

Don't Do This:

Do not recreate the logo or substitute other typefaces in place of using the approved logo file.



Do not alter the colors of the approved logo file. See official MSM colors on page 16.



Do not stretch or squish the logo file. Always maintain the correct proportion for all uses of the logo in all cases.



Do not use a low resolution or pixelated version of the logo. High resolution versions are available in various file types.



Do This:

When placing the logo, ensure there is proper clear space. A simple way to double check is to estimate the height of the logo's steeple base height (X) and use that measurement of white space to ensure the logo has breathing room and is set apart from other text or visuals on a page.



School Primary Logo Club Extension

Our primary logo includes an extension of applications to be used for official clubs and organizations to utilize.



Logo Extension Examples

All logo extensions should follow the established template (proportions, typefaces and construction). Please request logo extension to be created by the Office of Communications instead of trying to create it independently.



School Crests

Our school has adopted two crests for ceremonial and/or official uses. These crests should only be used with approval from the Director of Communications and should be used in places where the primary logo is also visible.

In an age of limited technology, wax seals like these crests were used to authenticate important messages. In a similar way, the MSM crests continue to provide that level of authentication for The Mount's most important documents. It officially represents Mount St. Mary Catholic High School and its use is mandatory on official communications and other important documents. The Mercy Crest is featured on all MSM approved uniforms but not on any fan gear or casual Mount apparel. Rare exceptions to these rules must be approved in writing by senior leadership.

MSM Mercy Crest

Celebrating our faith heritage, this crest should be used to remind our students, staff, faculty and visitors to live a life of Mercy.



MSM Academic Crest

Celebrating our academic heritage, this crest should be used on official communications - especially those academic in nature.



Advancement Logos

Our school is powered by the passionate philanthropy of hundreds of alumni, friends and supporters annually. The Mount offers ongoing recognition for our annual donors, and it is important to reflect consistency of our school's brand through these outlets as well.

Athletic Primary Logo

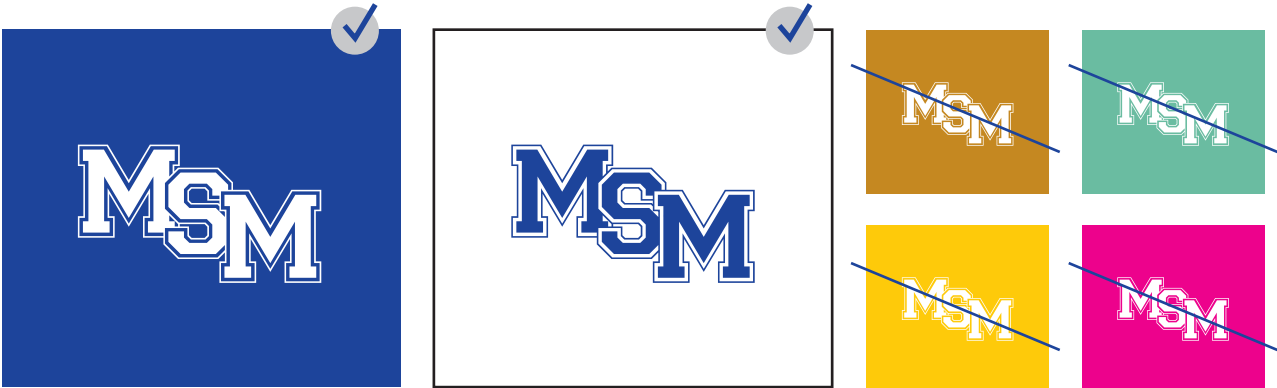
Our primary athletic logo continues the equity of our stacked MSM design. This logo is reserved exclusively for athletic use and should not be used in academic settings or other applications.



Acceptable Color Configurations

The athletic logo must only be produced in all MSM blue or all white on a blue background. Please do not reproduce the logo in a different color as to preserve our logo and brand equity in all uses.

Please note: while the primary use of the MSM logo should be on Blue or White backgrounds. However, there are certain instances where the application of the logo on other colors may be allowable for certain club or teams. For these exceptions, please secure approval from the Office of Communications prior to ordering signage, uniforms, etc. Thank you.
