Parking Rules
2024-2025

We appreciate your understanding and adherence to our parking policies. Parking on campus is a school safety issue, and we must be able to identify all vehicles. Thank you again as you read through this list.

NOTE: If a student has a 2024-2025 ECCA parking permit, an SEHS parking permit is NOT required.

It is required that both the parent and student read and understand the following parking rules:

1. I understand that parking on the SEHS campus is a privilege and may be revoked at any time. I understand that, should my permit be revoked, I will NOT receive a refund.
2. I understand that for the 2024-2025 school year, the parking permit is free. I understand that this may not apply to senior painted parking spaces.
3. I agree to park in the student parking lot ONLY.
4. If someone is parked in my designated space OR if I am driving a different vehicle, I agree to report this information to the AP Office immediately.
5. I understand that I must display a Parking Permit on the rear view mirror where the Parking Permit number is visible from outside the vehicle.
6. I understand that my parking permit is for my use only and may not be transferred to another person for any reason. I agree not to use another student's parking permit to display in my own vehicle. I understand that doing so will result in the revocation of parking privileges for both myself and the other student.
7. I understand the use or possession of alcohol, tobacco, or tobacco paraphernalia may result in revocation of the parking permit.
8. I understand that SEHS is not responsible for damage to my vehicle or to the contents of my vehicle.
9. I understand that I may not go to my vehicle and/or leave campus without permission from an administrator or office personnel. I understand that if I fail to obtain permission to leave the building and/or school grounds, my parking permit will be revoked.
10. I understand that vehicles parked on school grounds are subject to searches by school administrators and law enforcement officers at the request of school administration.
11. I understand that I am solely responsible for ALL contents of my car or the car that I am driving when it is on school grounds. I agree that lack of knowledge is not a reason or excuse for any unacceptable or illegal items to be in the vehicle.
12. I agree to avoid driving in a reckless manner. I agree to operate my vehicle responsibly and to avoid causing damage to public and private property located on school grounds, and to avoid endangering the life or limb of persons utilizing school facilities. I understand that this includes driving recklessly around buses en route to and from school or school functions.
13. I understand the following rules and regulations apply at all times, year-round, while operating a vehicle on campus:
 - a. You must have a parking permit to enter the lot.
 - b. The speed limit on campus is 5 miles per hour.
 - c. The traffic coming into the lot in the morning is one way and the traffic exiting the lot in the afternoon is one way.
 - d. Students who stay after school for extracurricular activities are to park only in the student parking lot.
 - e. The center lane of traffic has the right of way over the lanes coming from the parking areas.
 - f. Students are not allowed to arrive or exit out of the center circle in front of the school. That area is strictly for parent pickup and drop-off. All students must use the student parking gate for entry and exit.

To protect the safety of SEHS students and ensure the orderly flow of traffic in the parking lot, SEHS expects all drivers to adhere to certain rules and procedures.

If you commit any one of the following infractions, a \$25.00 ticket will be given and Parking Permit may be suspended or revoked:

- Parked in the wrong spot (i.e. painted senior spot, handicap, traffic circle, staff parking lot)
- Parking tag not visible
- Reckless driving (including excessive speed, driving across parking spots, carelessness around pedestrians)
- Improperly merging across driving lanes
- Occupying two spots

Subsequent infractions may result in disciplinary consequences.

NOTE: Some infractions may be deemed serious enough to warrant immediate fine or suspension/revocation of parking privileges.

Student Drivers are encouraged to arrive after 8:05 daily unless otherwise scheduled appointment with a teacher, coach, or club sponsored event.

IMPORTANT REMINDER:

It is your responsibility to bring in an updated copy to SEHS, should any of the vehicle information/documents expire or change during the 2024-2025 academic year.

NOTE TO PARENTS:

The intent for these rules is not to punish your child, but to keep the parking lot safe for all individuals. The students must be patient and courteous to others when entering and leaving the parking lot.

We have read and understand the above and attached rules. We agree to follow all rules and understand that parking privileges may be revoked by any administrator for violation of these or any other school policies and procedures. We understand that, if these privileges are revoked, ALL school property and areas next to the highways are off limits (**by order of the Sheriff's Department**).
