Proposition 28 funds were allocated to the district after 2 elementary art and 2 elementary music positions were funded out of LCAP and a Middle School Art and Music Elective are already in place. Additionally, materials funds were already allocated for these teachers to utilize in their classrooms. This grant holds a supplement not supplant clause. Expansion during the funded year 2023-2024 did not occur.

We have added a middle school art position for 2024-2025 and will continue to consider new opportunities as appropriately credentialed staff are available to expand current offerings with a teacher at each school site, to include alternate arts (performing, dramatic, dance, etc) or through the Prop 28 Waiver Process.
