4. 2022 - Illinois School Report Card

Summary: The Illinois Report Card offers a snapshot of school performance in order to inform and empower educators, families, and communities as they support their students. 6. BCBS Health Insurance Renewal (with Options)

Summary: March 1st is the renewal date with BCBS. BCBS is proposing a modest **5.4% increase** on your current plan where all of your employees are enrolled today but with a tweak to the benefits. The deductible and out of pocket maximum are adjusting up slightly but the coinsurance is going from **80% to 70%.** The school district is also being asked to consider two (2) additions to the current plan, S531PPO, rather than a replacement to it. The Renewal Option 1 S531BCE is the same plan design, just a tighter network on the Blue Choice Preferred network versus the larger PPO network you have today for some significant savings. The Renewal Option 2 G508OPT is a tiered option that actually incorporates two networks, the Blue Options network as the first tier with the richest benefits and the second tier is the large PPO network that you have today. **BCBS RENEWAL ANALYSIS**
