ARP LEA American Rescue Plan (ESSER III) Replacement of Contracted work to upgrade ventilators in 5 classrooms, the office, special education classroom, and stage contractor name cannot be added due to cost because it must be bid out once approved. \$12,500 Unit Ventilator. Total amount estimated at \$170,731. Chuck Newman and I spoke about this amount. Chuck needs to review this information. Dan McCurdy has estimated the cost of replacing a classroom unit ventilator to be:

\$12,500 – Unit Ventilator

7,500 – to add cooling

5,000 – to add pressure relief 1,000 – related additional work

= \$26,000 per classroom.

There are 8 units excluding the south addition to the building = \$208,000. With design fees that = about \$230,000. (Funding may be available with Life Safety funds, ISBE matching construction funds, or COVID related funds or a combination of those funds.)
