Without Charters

District #60 With Charters

- From 2007-08 to 2017-18
 - Pueblo City Schools enrollment without charters (excluding Early Childhood) decreased by 372 students or -2.5 percent
 - District #60 enrollment with charters (excluding Early Childhood) decreased by 931 students or -5.5 percent
 - The school age population in District #60 increased
 - The market share of the Pueblo City Schools (without charters) is 77.6 percent

- In ten years (2027-28)
 - Pueblo City Schools enrollment without charters is projected to range from 12,093 to 12,590, a decrease from the 2017-18 enrollment of 14,467 (excluding Early Childhood) or a decrease of -13.0 percent to -16.4 percent
 - District #60 enrollment with charters is projected to range from 13,898 to 14,375 compared to 2017-18 enrollment of 16,059 (excluding Early Childhood) or a decrease of -10.5 percent to -13.5 percent
 - Room to accommodate adding grades at PSAS plus others

- In ten years,
 - Enrollment will decrease in the elementary schools first. Enrollment decreases in the high schools will occur in the second five projection years
 - Several factors account for these decreases
 - Births in the District are down and are projected to remain near today's level in the near-term future. The District's population is older and current fertility rates are low
 - The Pueblo City Schools have a long history of net out migration at nearly every grade

- More resident students are opting to leave the District through open enrollment including online options
- Projected increase in housing units is modest and new units are not adding may school age children
- The Pueblo City Schools without charters is unusual because the schools lose many students in the transition from elementary school to middle school (Grade 5 to Grade 6). Some of these students may return for high school, but some are lost
 - True for District #60 with charters as well

- What could occur to make these projections:
 - Too high
 - Increased competition from charter schools and external online schools/programs
 - Too low
 - More kindergarten students than projected
 - Capture more District residents?

 - The larger average elementary grade compared to the average middle school grade does not signal future enrollment increases because the net out migration from Grade 5 to Grade 6 recently exceeds the net in migration from Grade 8 to Grade 9

 - 25.2 percent of births occur in the last quarter of the year




