Citizens' Facility Advisory Committee (CFAC) School Board Charge:

The Lakewood School District is anticipating a wave of development in the next 10 years which will bring significantly increased student enrollment. This reality, combined with aging facilities and a now outdated Study and Survey (completed in 2011), requires that we once again review facility needs. Forming a Citizens' Facilities Advisory Committee to review the needs of our facilities will provide the Lakewood School Board and community with a recommended road map to guide future capital investments.

The Citizens' Facility Advisory Committee (CFAC) is a community-based work group whose purpose is to recommend to the Lakewood School Board a short-and long-term capital improvement plan in the form of a new Study and Survey.

To achieve the goal, the following activities need to be completed at a minimum:

- Review the previous CFAC recommendation in the previous Study and Survey (2011)
- Review facilities improvements completed since the previous Study and Survey
- Review the physical conditions of the district facilities
- Review and revise current space and service standards as needed
- Evaluate district operational systems through the lens of their efficiency and longevity
- Review district demographic and student growth projections to anticipate future needs
- Review the programmatic needs of the district based on current and anticipated educational trends or requirements, including instructional and educational models likely to be in place in the district
- Consider any other trends, conditions or potential needs relating to facilities and operations that arise during the Study and Survey process
- Update the Board of Directors on a regular basis as determined by the Board
- Solicit community input through a variety of methods which may potentially include surveys and/or community forums
- Present the new Study and Survey: Long-term Capital Facilities Plan to the School Board that addresses identified needs

A member of the CFAC commits to the following:

- Attending regular meetings of the Committee twice per month from February 2023 through October 2023. (Meetings will not be held in July)
- Completing the scope and charge of the CFAC as defined by the Board of Directors
- Support the collection of community input during the Study and Survey process
- Openly considering and deliberating about potential recommendations with a focus on evidence and data
- Residing in the Lakewood School District
