

Comprehensive Sexual Health Education Instructional Materials Committee

Board Update 6/15/22

Meeting Updates:

- **March 30, 2022**
 - First meeting of team. The team includes four community members/parents, three students, one paraeducator, three teachers, two school administrators and one district administrator.
 - Team reviewed process and requirements of law.

- **April 28, 2022**
 - Briefly overviewed the materials approved by OSPI
 - FLASH
 - Get Real
 - Great Body Shop
 - Health Smart
 - Positive Prevention Plus
 - Rights, Respect, Responsibility
 - Unanimously agreed to focus on selecting one of the six approved by OSPI vs. locally developing entirely new curriculum (allowed by law).

- **May 19, 2022**
 - The team broke into three groups based on grade band interest: 4-5, 6-8, 9-12 (No sexuality content or curriculum is required for K-3 students).
 - Used OSPI provided Sexual Health Education Curriculum Review documents to begin initial screening.

- **June 2, 2022**
 - Used OSPI provided Sexual Health Education Curriculum Review documents to complete initial screening.
 - Team agreed to narrow to these curricular materials:
 - FLASH (grades 4-12)
 - Great Body Shop (grades 4-5)/Get Real (grades 6-12)
 - Rights, Respect, Responsibility (grades 4-12)

- **June 13, 2022**
 - Team selected Great Body Shop (grades 4-5)/Get Real (grades 6-12) unanimously.

Timeline:

- **June 2022:** Team will recommend Comprehensive Sexual Health Education curriculum materials to the Curriculum and Instructional Materials Committee (CIMC)
- **July 2022:** Recommended Comprehensive Sexual Health Education curriculum materials will be made available for preview by members of the community via district website and in person viewing.
- **Early August 2022:** CIMC will consider approval of materials and recommend to the School Board.
- **Mid-August 2022:** School Board will consider CIMC recommended materials for approval.
- **September 2022:** Community Forum
