



Gifted and Talented Program Process Union County Vocational-Technical Schools

UCVTS career academies (Academy for Allied Health Sciences, Academy for Information Technology, Academy for Performing Arts, Magnet High School, Union County Vocational-Technical High School) are CTE schools that are populated by students who meet admissions criterion that is centered on student achievement. Admitted students are evaluated for entry into the appropriate honors-level or above CTE program.

Students participate in an honors-level program that allows for students to take coursework at the honors-level or above. Additionally, students can be used for credit at institutions such as Rutgers University, Kean University, New Jersey Institute of Technology, and Union County College. Additionally, identified students are able to participate in internship programs that cater to each program's CTE focus.
