Personalized student learning is defined as **student-centered learning experiences** intentionally designed by educators to achieve student mastery of instructional outcomes utilizing delivery methods and tools that honor individual student needs, voice, choice, and learning time. Universal Design for Learning (UDL) is the method for planning personalized instruction.



Textbook Adoptions

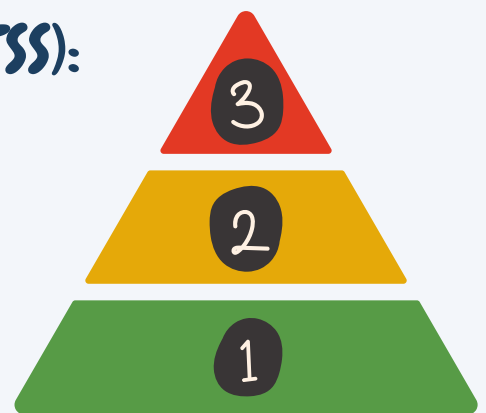
Textbook adoptions are made on a rotating cycle with the most recent adoptions of middle school social science and elementary math.

Multi-tiered System of Support (MTSS): Academic

Tier 1: Grade Level Standards and Core Curriculum (**All Students**)

Tier 2: Personalized In-Class Supports and Interventions (**Some Students**)

Tier 3: Personalized Intensive Supports and Interventions (**Few Students**)



English Learner Program: ELD & EL Reclassification System

RSD is committed to reclassifying **ALL** English learner (EL) students as fluent English proficient **prior to completion of grade eight**. This is achieved through the implementation and monitoring of **intentional strategies** to increase student language acquisition, achievement, and goal-setting success.

Assessment: RSD Assessment Cycles

Daily/Weekly Assessments include checks for understanding, Common Formative assessments, teacher observation, rubrics, and other teacher-made formative assessments

Quarterly/Semesterly: iReady Diagnostics (Math & Reading), iReady Growth Monitoring, Units of Study, Culminating Tasks (CTs) & Performance Tasks (PTs), ESGI (TK-K), BPS or DRA

Annually: CAASPP/CAA in English Language Arts (ELA) & Math, CAST/CAA Science, ELPAC



Professional Development
