### **Parent Right to Know**

Leetonia Exempted Village School District receives Federal Title I funding and as a parent, you have the right to know the professional qualifications of the classroom teachers who instruct your child. Federal law allows you to ask for certain information about your child's classroom teacher and requires us to give you this information in a timely manner, if you ask for it.

### **Highly Qualified Teachers**

The Leetonia Village Exempted School District is striving to provide the best education for your child. As part of our efforts, we are complying with the NO Child Left Behind Act that requires all teachers to be highly qualified. As a parent or guardian, you may request information regarding the professional qualifications of your child's classroom teachers including the following information:

- Whether the teacher has met state qualification and licensing criteria for the grade level and subject areas taught.
- Whether the teacher is teaching under emergency or provisional status.
- Baccalaureate degree major, graduation certification, and field of discipline.
- Whether the student is provided services by a paraprofessional and if so, their qualifications.

## **Parent Involvement Policy**
