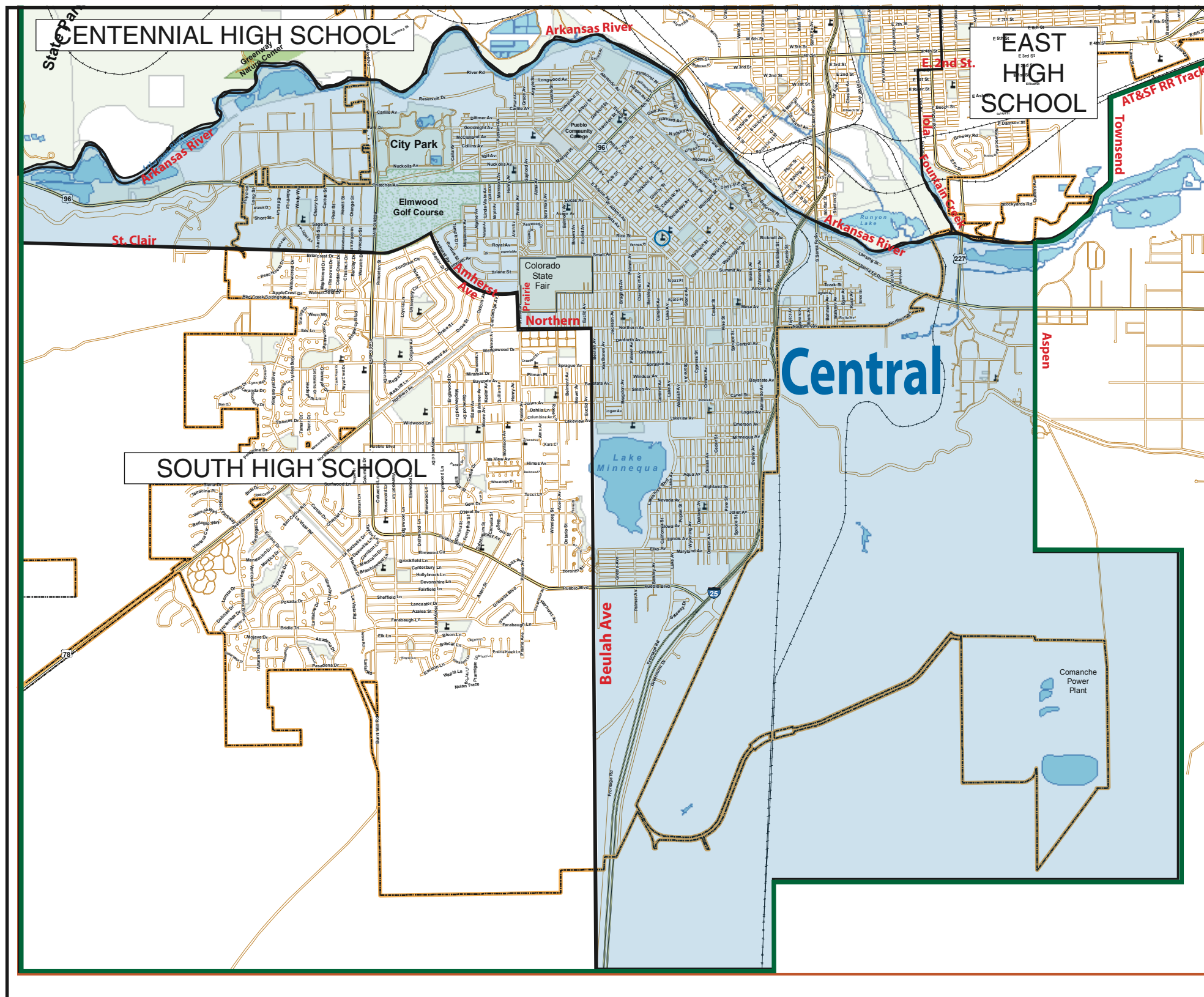

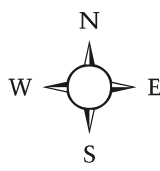
Central High School Boundaries

CENTRAL HIGH SCHOOL BOUNDARIES DESCRIPTION

Unless other wise specified, all boundary lines refer to an imaginary line down the middle of the street.

Southern boundary of Central High School: Beginning at a point where Beulah Avenue intersects with the District No. 60 southern boundary; north on both sides of Beulah Avenue to Northern Avenue; west on both sides of Northern Avenue to Prairie; north on both sides of Prairie to Amherst; west on both sides of Amherst to St. Clair; west on north side of St. Clair; west on north side of St. Clair to western boundary of District 60.

Northern boundary of Central High school: Beginning at a point where the Arkansas River would intersect with the District No. 60 western boundary; east on the Arkansas River to a point where Aspen Street would intersect; the eastern and southern boundaries of School District 60 are the boundaries of Central High School to the point where Beulah Avenue intersects with the District No. 60 southern boundary.
