## ASSESSMENT HIGHLIGHTS

### K-3 IDAHO READING INDICATOR (IRI) ASSESSMENT

Carberry led the district with 69% of 3rd grade students reading at grade level on the May assessment.

### IDAHO STANDARDS OF ACHIEVEMENT TEST (ISAT) 3RD-5TH GRADE (SPRING 2024)

ELA, Mathematics, & Science averages across the district are above or within two percentage points of the state average.

### IDAHO STANDARDS OF ACHIEVEMENT TEST (ISAT) 6TH-8TH GRADE (SPRING 2024)

Math & ELA scores increased in Grades 6th-8th, reducing the gap between ESD & state averages.

### IDAHO STANDARDS OF ACHIEVEMENT TEST (ISAT) 11TH GRADE (SPRING 2024)

Emmett High School Mathematics & ELA scores were above the state average.
