What's New at the View

Walk Through Monday, July 29th!

Our Walk Through is scheduled for Monday, July 29th from 11:00-12:30 for rising 9th graders and students new to Creekview. All other students are welcome to come that day from 1:30-3:00 if desired. Bring a copy of your schedule to follow on your self-guided tour of the school. Staff will be available to pull up schedules on the computer for students to take a picture, if necessary, but you can avoid the line and start your tour of the school if you bring your copy. Paper copies will not be provided at Walk Through.

Teachers will be available during Walk Through for general information, but if you have questions relating specifically to your student, you may reach out to them by email after Walk Through. Schedules

Schedules were viewable on ParentVUE and StudentVUE by the end of the day on July 25th. IF there is an issue with your student's schedule, please EMAIL your child's counselor.

Counselors will be working on scheduling issues that are: 1) Academic Course issue, the wrong course for a subject is on your student's schedule 2) A student is missing a class period on their schedule 3) A student is missing his/her Lunch Period. No lunch period or teacher requests will be accepted. Unfortunately, due to our enrollment number, we will not be able to accommodate elective changes at this time.

Please note that we are navigating a new SIS (Student Information System), so it will take us a little longer to make scheduling adjustments. Counselors are working as quickly as possible to make corrections on any scheduling issues in the order they are received. Please continue to check ParentVUE and/or StudentVUE through the first day of school, August 1st for any updated changes.
