Annual Women's Health and Cancer Rights Act Notification

Dear Member:

In October 1998, the U.S. government enacted the federal Women's Health and Cancer Rights Act of 1998.

This law requires us to inform our plan members, each year, about major provisions of the law. These provisions require health plans that cover mastectomies to also cover (after any applicable deductible and coinsurance):

- All stages of reconstruction and surgery of the breast on which the mastectomy was performed.
- Surgery and reconstruction of the other breast to produce a symmetrical appearance.
- Prostheses.
- Treatment of physical complications of a mastectomy, including lymphedema.
