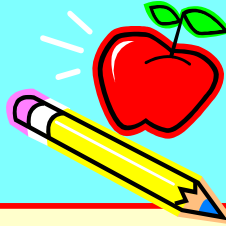

Some Important Information

We had a wonderful first day of learning about rules, writing, reviewing grammar concepts, reading character books, and sharing about ourselves.
